Experiences

<u>Clinical Experience</u>

Minia University Hospital is the 2nd biggest hospital in Upper Egypt. It is a 1200 bedded hospital.

The Department of Tropical Medicine consists of about 30 beds including Hepatology and Gastroenterology Unit, Infectious diseases Unit, Abdominal Ultrasonography Unit and G.I.T. endoscopy Units.

-During residency period I had to attend every day in the outpatient gastroenterology and hepatology clinic and infectious disease clinic , 2 -3 days (24 hours) per week in the inpatient department and one day per week in the emergency department dealing with GIT emergency cases. I dealt with several hundreds of all the hepatic, gastrointestinal, and infectious diseases especially those prevalent in my country in addition to hepatic, gastrointestinal, and abdominal emergencies. This was in addition to 2 GIT endoscopy sessions per week; Abdominal Ultrasound session; -During period while I was an assistant lecturer I had to supervise residents in the hepatology , GIT outpatient clinic 2 days per week and one day (24 hours) in the inpatient GIT unit.

-Now I am a consultant one day per week in the hepatology, gastroentrology outpatient clinic and one day (24 hours) in the inpatient GIT unit.

-I participate in most of the seminars, journal clubs, case presentations and conferences related to my specialities and interests; and assistance in some clinically-based studies and projects.

Endoscopic Experience

- I work at minia university hospital GIT endoscopy unit since 2008 two days per week till now and at emergency GIT endoscopy unit since decemper 2009 till june 2016 dealing with different cases of GIT emergency
- I have learned to do diagnostic and therapeutic upper and lower GIT endoscopy
- I have little experience in doing ERCP
- I had to go to Wadi Elneel hospital GIT endoscopy unit at Cairo two days per month to follow up my MD thesis work with prof dr ibrahim moustafa, from march 2012 till june 2015, I had attended regularly with dr ibrahim and prof Andrea Vangossome doing single ballon enteroscopy and small bowel video capsule endoscopy
- I have attended several endoscopic workshops in Egypt to learn principles of double ballon enteroscopy and to improve myself in doing ERCP
- Now I attend regularly with prof husein okasha through Egyptian society of EUS to learn how to do EUS
