E Clinical Experience

I received my <u>undergraduate</u> and part of my postgraduate training at Minia University Hospital, which are 800 bedded. It is located in Minia and serves a population of about 2 millions. Between 01/03/01 & 28/02/02 I completed my *pre-registration HO* training.

In March 02, I have been offered <u>a residency training post</u> at Minia University Hospital which 800 bedded teaching hospital and is serving a major part of Upper Egypt population. There are cardiothoracic, neurosurgery, paediatric, Vascular, plastic, and oncology units. This is backed by up to date Laboratory, Diagnostic (CT) & interventional Radiology and Nuclear Medicine departments. Plus that, part of my training was received in Minia Oncology Centre which 100 bedded highly specialized centre in cancer management with surgery, chemotherapy & radiotherapy. It receives about 4000 new cancer case every year. As a registrar I gained good experience in managing cancer cases with chemotherapy and radiotherapy.

In Oct. 2005, I <u>defended my M.Sc.thesis</u>. It was a retrospective study of breast cancer cases in minia oncology center. It was an evaluation of about 900 case of breast cancer that represent our patient that attended to our centre in three years. **In Dec.2005**, I <u>passed my .M.Sc. exam.</u>

<u>In May. 2006</u>, I have been offered an upgradeable permanent post as an assistant lecturer in Clinical Oncology Department at Minia University Hospital in Minia.

In August 2008, I was granted a 2 year fellowship to UK as a part of my MD research project. I did a 2 year of clinical and research training under Dr Rob Glynne Jones Supervision in GIT department in Mount Vernon Cancer Centre based in north london.

Mount Vernon Caner Centre is considered one of the top five centres in UK. My supervising consultant was the chair of anal cancer in whole UK and his research department participates in major trials in gastrointestinal malignances in Europe like ACT II Trial. During this time I rotated in different hospital clinics and get contact with staff like Peter Hoskin, Professour Rustin...etc, attended many oncology course plus skilled course in pain management. I participated in many publications with many of them see light and published. I got the opportunity to do 1st part of FRCR which is composed of (Cancer Biology that gives me clear knowledge of mechanisms of tumour resistance and mechanism of action of targeted therapies, I studied also Cancer Pharmacology, Physics and Research Statistics).

In Kuwait, I worked at GIT Medical Oncology Unit which consolidate my knowledge of gastrointestinal malignances. I joined GIT Medical Oncology Unit from September 2013 till now. In our unit we follow most up todate oncology evidence based protocols.
